

DRSS Contract of Agreement National Honor Society

Expectations of NHS:

1. Volunteer at NHS events or any other group volunteer opportunity for at least 6 hours every semester.
2. Complete a individual-project (6 hours required).
3. Submit forms for hour completion (individual and group forms are separate).
4. Come to every meeting on time or with a valid pass (from a teacher, administrator, etc.).

Rules of NHS:

1. If you miss meetings for an unexcused reason, then you must communicate with an NHS officer and you are required to complete an additional group hour.
 - a. You must attend at least 75% of the mandatory meetings on time, otherwise you may be removed from NHS.
2. If you miss meetings for an excused reason, you are still required to communicate with an NHS officer as soon as possible.
3. If you do not meet the service hour requirements for each semester then you will be placed on probation.
4. If you do not meet the service hour requirements for two consecutive semesters you will be removed from NHS and will not be permitted to wear the NHS stole at graduation.

Important Information:

1. NHS events are events approved by Maya Quale (Parliamentarian), Brianna Perkins (Service Director), or Ms. Camden and can be found on the Google Document titled, "NHS Volunteer Opportunities" or the NHS Website.
2. Forms for hour (group/individual) completion can be found in Ms. Camden's classroom.
3. Forms for hour completion must be turned in into the folder in Ms. Camden's room.
4. Excused reasons for missing meetings include: absence or scheduled meeting with teacher. Unexcused reasons include: not wanting to or forgetting about it.
5. Group specific meetings outside of mandatory meetings DO NOT count towards group hours.
